**“God was manifested  
in the flesh”**

1 Timothy 3:16

The Apostle Paul wrote this.

Notice, Paul did **not** say,

“God’s son was manifested in the flesh,”

Paul was speaking of the One and only God, **The Almighty Father** being manifested in flesh.

The manifestation of The Almighty Father in flesh **was Yahshua MessiYah**.

**Yahshua MessiYah** was The Almighty Father **come in flesh**.

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh, **as a human**, as our ‘**Kinsmen Redeemer**’, in order to **fulfill the demands of the Law on our behalf**.

The Almighty Father did **FOR US** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves!

Then, on the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, thereby making us “**holy, blameless**” and “**without a single fault**” in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

**This is the gospel! This is the Good News!**

**Salvation is a gift for you**

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon Yahshua MessiYah, *The Almighty Father manifested in flesh*.

The **gift** of salvation cannot be earned by our deeds, works or fruitless self-righteous attempts at ‘keeping the Law’. We cannot obtain it by being a “good person” or by attending church.

Yahshua earned it **for us** by dying for **our** sins on the cross.

*“For by **grace** you have been saved through **faith**, and that **not of yourselves**; it is the **gift** of God*

Ephesians 2:8

**Everyone** who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

**The Old Testament tells us there  
is no Savior but the Father.**

*I, I am Yahweh, and there is no other  
Savior but **Me**.*

Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but Me,  
a righteous God and Savior.  
There is none but **Me**.*

Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but Me;  
For there is no savior besides **Me**.*

Hosea 13:4

**The New Testament tells us  
Yahshua is the Savior.**

*To those who have obtained like  
precious faith with us by the  
righteousness of **our God and Savior**  
Jesus Christ:*

2 Peter 1:1

looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of **our great God and Savior**, Christ Jesus, Titus 2:13

but now has been revealed by the appearing of **our Savior** Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, 2 Timothy 1:10

For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have fixed our hope on the living God, who is the **Savior** of all men, especially of believers. 1 Timothy 4:10

and they were saying to the woman, "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves and know that this One is indeed the **Savior** of the world." John 4:42

The apostle Thomas cried out to Yahshua...

**"My Lord and my God!"**  
John 20:28

Are we to believe that when Thomas proclaimed Yahshua to be "God" he was not proclaiming Yahshua to be **The Almighty Father?**

And, what about the apostle Paul, who called Yahshua...

**"our great God and Savior."**  
Titus 2:13

And what about the apostle Peter who said...

*"To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of **our God and Savior** Jesus Christ: 2 Peter 1:1*

**"one God and Father of all".**

Ephesians 4:6 tells us there is **"one God and Father of all"**. Since we **know** Yahshua is God, we know He is **The Almighty Father** manifested in flesh.

Isaiah prophesied that the **"Son"** who was to come would be called **"Mighty God"** and **"Everlasting Father"**. (Isaiah 9:6)

*For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a **Son** is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, **Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.***

Isaiah 9:6

Isaiah tells us our Messiyah **will be a son in His humanity** (*unto us a Child is born*), the **Holy Spirit**, the **Everlasting Father** and the **Mighty God!**

**Philip asked to see the Father, not realizing who Yahshua actually was.**

In John 14:7 Yahshua told His disciples,

*"If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."*  
Upon hearing this statement, Philip requested, **"Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."**  
John 14:8

Philip asked if Yahshua would **"show" them the Father** and then they would be satisfied.

**Notice** how Yahshua responded,

***"Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"***

Like many people today, Philip did not comprehend that **The Almighty Father** is an invisible Spirit; the only way a person could ever see Him would be by seeing **Yahshua Messiyah**, **"God manifested in the flesh"**.
