**In the Old Testament, a person teaching  
The Almighty's people  
to worship 'three distinct persons'  
would have been put to death!**

The Jewish people were warned continually to stay **far away** from pagan '**polytheism**' by The Almighty Father **Himself**:

*"Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God,  
the LORD is one!"*

Deuteronomy 6:4

What divides Jewish people from Trinitarianism is whether The Almighty is One (**singular**), or a composite of '**three persons**'. The bedrock of Judaism has always been **true monotheism** - the belief that The Almighty is a **singular** One.

This belief in **one singular** Almighty is what distinguished the Jewish people from their neighbors, who during antiquity were **polytheistic**.

The Jewish people have always safeguarded their **monotheism** against Trinitarian proselytizing. To them, the Catholic and Protestant 'Trinity Doctrine' is blasphemous, for they believe the 'trinity god' to be a **different** god than The Almighty God of Scripture.

How can the Jewish people (**or any Believer**) accept the 'Trinity Doctrine' which tells them The Almighty is a **composite** of '**three distinct persons**', when this **refutes** the very words of **The Almighty Father Himself**?

In the Bible, false prophets claimed to speak the Word of God, but instead spread false teachings **contrary** to The Fathers own words.

Any prophet who **contradicted** what The Almighty Father had previously revealed in His Word, **proved himself to be a false prophet**.

To **protect** His people, The Almighty Father commanded **false prophets** be put to death.

Today, people engage in intellectual debates about who the Father is. Is our Savior the Father, is our Savior a second person in the Trinity Doctrine?

But Yahshua is having none of it, He speaks clearly and truthfully to those who will listen. He is **I AM, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh** and no debating or intellectualizing will change that. No man, tradition or denomination will change that.



The Almighty Father tells us in Isaiah 43:11  
*"there is no other Savior but **Me**."*

**The Almighty Father** manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do **for us** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. **He fulfilled the demands of the Law as a perfect man of flesh**, so that **He** could be **our perfect sacrifice** and '**kinsman-redeemer**'! On the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, paying **our** price and thereby making us "**holy, blameless**" and "**without a single fault**" in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

This is the gospel! **This is the Good News!**

Here are important questions that you, your family, your friends, your pastor, your church, your denomination, your tradition... and **all** of us must answer.

Do you believe The Almighty Father is the **only Savior** as **He** says He is?

Do you believe Yahshua MessiYah is the '**I AM**' of Exodus 3:14 as **He** says He "**Truly, truly**" is?

Do you believe Yahshua MessiYah is **The Almighty Father manifested in flesh**?

I pray your answers are '**Yes**' and when proclaiming your Savior, you will say...

**Yahshua MessiYah, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh, is my Savior.**

# You must believe the Father is your Savior or you will die in your sins

The Almighty Father is the **only** Savior. He tells us this **Himself**.

*I, even I, am the LORD,  
And besides **Me** there is no savior.*  
Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but **Me**, a righteous God  
and Savior. **There is none but Me**.*  
Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but **Me**;  
For there is **no savior besides Me**.*  
Hosea 13:4

These scriptures are clear, The Almighty Father is the Savior; He is the **only** Savior.

## Isaiah's prophecy - The Almighty Father will come to us manifested in flesh

This is what the prophet Isaiah **told us was going to happen!** The Almighty Father **Himself** was going to come to us born in flesh as a man!

*For unto us **a Child is born**, Unto us a **Son** is given;  
And the government will be upon His shoulder.  
And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor,  
**Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.***  
Isaiah 9:6

Isaiah told us our "**Mighty God**" and "**Everlasting Father**" would come to us as a "**Son**" because He was going to be "**born**" of a woman and would be a **man made of flesh**.

**He would be human!**

We see Isaiah's prophesy fulfilled in Matthew 1:23,

*"Behold, the virgin shall be with **child**, and bear a **Son**, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "**God with us**."*

Isaiah 9:6  
unto us a **child** is **born**...  
Unto us a **Son** is given...  
*His name... Mighty God, Everlasting Father*

Matthew 1:23  
the virgin shall be with **child**,  
and bear a **Son**...  
*His name... God with us*

## The Almighty Father appears to Moses

When The Almighty Father appeared to Moses in the burning bush, Moses asked His name.

The Almighty Father gave Moses this reply:

*"I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: '**I AM** has sent me to you.'"* Exodus 3:14

Ever since this name was spoken by The Almighty Father, the Israelites considered the name "**I AM**" to be sacred. This name was not to be used in vain or bestowed on **anyone** other than **The Almighty Father Himself**.

The Apostle John tells us that one day the Pharisees came to question Yahshua. At the conclusion, Yahshua responded to their questions by saying this...

*"**Truly, truly** I say to you, before Abraham was born, **I AM**."* John 8:58

Here, Yahshua calls **Himself** the ancient and sacred name of The Almighty Father, "**I AM**".

Yahshua was telling them that **He** was The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14 that they **claimed** to worship. Because the Pharisees knew **exactly** what Yahshua meant, they became enraged and picked up stones to kill Him for blasphemy.

## Yahshua proclaims that **He is I AM**

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am (*He*), you will die in your sins."

Notice the (*He*) in this verse is in italics, which means that it was not in the original Greek, but was **added** by the translators. The (*He*) in italics was **NOT** spoken by Yahshua. This added word completely obscures the fact that Yahshua was claiming to be the great "**I AM**" of the Old Testament (Exodus 3:14, John 8:58).

The Greek words translated as "I am" are 'EGO EIMI' which is: "**I AM**".

John 8:24 is actually as follows,

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that **I AM**, you will die in your sins."

What Yahshua tells us is clear and unambiguous, it is not open to more than one interpretation. His message is this, "**if you do not believe that I AM you will die in your sins**."

According to Yahshua, rightly believing **who** He is, is **essential** for salvation.

Yahshua makes it clear that for a person to be saved from sin, they **must believe** that **He** is **The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14**.

**Why** must a person believe that Yahshua is The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14?

The answer is simple. It is because **The Almighty Father, as scripture states, is the only Savior!** He is the **only** one that can save someone from their sins. **There is no other Savior!**

Therefore, if a person does not believe Yahshua Messiyah is '**I AM**'; **The Almighty Father and only Savior**, they will die in their sins.

## Trinitarians must choose

It is undebatable that "**I AM**" is **The Almighty Father** of Exodus 3:14.

It is undebatable that in the New Testament, Yahshua proclaims that **He is "I AM"**.

Knowing that our Savior proclaimed to be **I AM**, Trinitarians will still deny that Yahshua Messiyah **is The Almighty Father** come manifested in flesh.

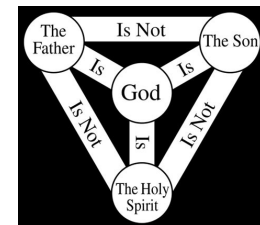
**Why** don't Trinitarians acknowledge that Yahshua Messiyah is The Almighty Father manifested in flesh?

It is because Trinitarians do not believe The Almighty is a '**singular**' One, even though the Father and the Scriptures **clearly** and **repeatedly** tell us that **He is**.

Trinitarians, strangely and un-scripturally believe The Almighty is a being composed of '**three distinct persons**' who, **in combination**, make one God.

Because Trinitarians have been taught that Yahshua and the Father are **two distinct persons**, they are unable to see the scriptural truth that Yahshua **is The Almighty Father Manifested in flesh**.

For those who believe in the 'Trinity Doctrine', **it is not possible in their eyes** for Yahshua to be The Almighty Father manifested in flesh because the 'Trinity Doctrine' **emphatically** teaches, "**The Father is Not the Son**" and "**the Son is Not the Father**."

Trinitarians must choose whether they will listen to the 'Trinity Doctrine' (a product of the Catholic church) or, whether they will listen to the words of our Savior.
