

**In every instance, Yahshua  
welcomed worship**

Scriptures show not only that Yahshua was worshiped, but that He welcomed and accepted worship.

Mark 5:6

*When he saw Yahshua from afar, he ran  
**and worshiped Him.***

John 9:38

*Then he said, "Lord, I believe!"  
**And he worshiped Him.***

Matthew 8:2

*And behold, a leper came **and worshiped Him,**  
saying, "Lord if You are willing, You can make me  
clean." Then Yahshua put out His hand and touched  
him, saying, I am willing; be cleansed.*

Matthew 9:18

*While He spoke these things to them, behold, a ruler  
came **and worshiped Him,** saying, "My daughter has  
just died, but come and lay Your hand on her and  
she will live."*

Matthew 15:25

*Then she came **and worshiped Him,** saying,  
"Lord, help me!"*

Thomas worshiped Yahshua when he saw Him alive  
again.

*And Thomas answered and said to Him,  
**"My Lord and my God!"***

John 20:28

Matthew 28:17

*When they saw Him, **they worshiped Him***

Two memorable examples of Yahshua accepting  
worship occurred just after His resurrection when "Mary  
Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb."

*"So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and  
great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word.  
And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Yahshua  
met them, saying, "Rejoice!" **So they came and held  
Him by the feet and worshiped Him.**"*

Matthew 28:8-9

**Question:**

Yahshua **clearly** told us...

***"the true worshipers will worship the Father  
in spirit and truth"***

**Why** then did **He** allow people to worship **Him**?

**The Answer:**

Yahshua allowed people to worship Him because **He  
was The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.**

**Salvation is a gift for you!**

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon  
Yahshua Messiyah, **The Almighty Father manifested  
in flesh.** The **gift** of salvation cannot be **earned** by  
our deeds, works, or fruitless *self-righteous* attempts  
at 'keeping the Law'. We cannot obtain it by being a  
"good person" or by attending church.

We can only receive our salvation **as a gift** from  
Yahshua Messiyah... **to us.**

**Everyone** who calls upon the name of Yahshua **will be  
saved,** so call upon Him **now.** Tomorrow is not assured.

**Yahshua is The Almighty

**A question for you...**

***Is The Almighty Father the Savior?***

Savior but **Me.***

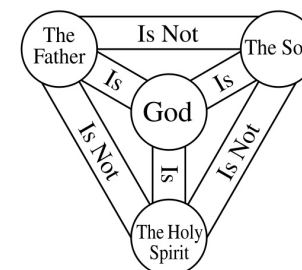
Isaiah 43:11

The Almighty Father **Himself** tells us **He** is the Savior.

**The Almighty Father is I AM**

Scriptures unarguably show, "**I AM**" is The Almighty  
Father. (Exodus 3:13-14)

According to the 'Trinity Doctrine', "The Father is **not**  
the Son" and "The Son is **not** the Father". Therefore,  
according to the 'Trinity Doctrine', **it is not possible**  
for Yahshua to be "**I AM**" because Yahshua is **the**  
**Son**; Yahshua is **not** the Father.

## Yahshua says something very important in John 8:24 that all people should heed

“Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins.”

Notice the “*He*” in this verse is in italics, which means that it was not in the original Greek, but was added by the translators. The “*He*” in italics was NOT spoken by Yahshua. This added word completely obscures the fact that Yahshua was claiming to be the great “**I AM**” of the Old Testament (Exodus 3:14, John 8:58).

The Greek words translated as “I am” are ‘EGO EIMI’ which is: “**I AM**”.

John 8:24 is actually as follows,

“Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that **I AM**, you will die in your sins.”

What Yahshua tells us is clear and unambiguous, it is not open to more than one interpretation. His message is this, if you do not believe that **I AM** you will die in your sins.

According to Yahshua, rightly believing who He is, is essential for salvation.

Yahshua makes it clear that for a person to be saved from sin, they must believe that He is The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14.

Why must this be?

The answer is simple. It is because The Almighty Father, as scripture states, **is the only Savior!** He is the only one that can save someone from their sins. There is no other Savior!

Therefore, if a person does not believe Yahshua is **I AM**, The Almighty Father and only Savior, they will die in their sins.

Thirty four verses later in John 8:58, Yahshua emphatically repeats His declaration that He is **I AM**, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

*“**Most assuredly**, I say to you, before Abraham was, **I AM.**”*

Today, people engage in intellectual debates about who the Father is. Is our Savior the Father, is our Savior a second person in the Trinity Doctrine?

But Yahshua is having none of it, He speaks clearly and truthfully to those who will listen. He is **I AM** and no debating or intellectualizing will change that. No man, tradition or denomination will change that.

## Philip learns from Yahshua that the Father is not a different and distinct person from Himself

In John 14:8-9, Philip asks Yahshua to show them the Father,

*“Lord, **show us the Father**, and it is sufficient for us.”*

Philip asked if Yahshua would show them the Father and then they would be satisfied.

Notice how Yahshua responds. Yahshua seems genuinely perplexed by Philip's request... and responds,

*Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip?  
**He who has seen Me has seen the Father;**  
**so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?***

Philip walked with, talked with, ate with and witnessed the miracles of Yahshua every day... and yet Philip did not realize who Yahshua truly was!

Like many people today, Philip did not realize that Yahshua was The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

Have you, like Philip, walked and talked with Yahshua everyday **and not yet realized who He truly is?**

## Yahshua said, “*true worshipers will worship the Father*” Yahshua welcomes and accepts worship

*“But the hour is coming, and now is, when the **true worshipers** will worship **the Father** in spirit and truth”*  
John 4:23

According to Yahshua, “**true worshipers** will worship **the Father**”.

Scriptures show people worshiped Yahshua.

## Even from the beginning of Yahshua’s life, He was worshiped

“Now after Yahshua was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, saying,

“Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and **have come to worship Him**”.

And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, **and fell down and worshiped Him.**”

Matthew 2:2, 11

Yahshua was worshiped as a baby.

Yahshua was worshiped by His disciples.

Yahshua was worshiped by everyday people.

Yahshua was worshiped by demon possessed people.

Yahshua was worshiped after His resurrection.
