

Paul knew **YAH**shua MessiYah was **YAH** manifested in flesh

Before we begin, let us understand these names.

YAH is The Almighty Fathers name. **YAH** is not an abbreviated form of the Almighty Father's name; **YAH** is His name. (Psalm 68:4; Isaiah 12: 2; Isaiah 26:4; Revelation 19:1, 3, 4, 6) Hallelu-**YAH** means, Praise **YAH**.

*Sing to God, sing praises to His name,
Extol Him who rides on the clouds,
By His name **YAH**, And rejoice before Him.*
Psalm 68:4

*Behold, God is my salvation,
I will trust and not be afraid;
For **YAH**, the LORD, is my strength and song;
He also has become my salvation.*
Isaiah 12:2

YAH-weh is a **compound** name which means, **YAH** - The Self Existent One (**I AM**). In the Old Testament The Almighty Father combined His name with the Hebrew word 'weh', which means 'the Self Existent One (**I AM**)'

YAH-shua is a **compound** name which means, **YAH** is Salvation. When The Almighty Father came to us **Himself** manifested in flesh, He combined His name with His highest descriptor ever, the Hebrew word '**shua**'. 'Shua' means, 'is salvation'. **YAH**-shua means, '**YAH** is Salvation'. This is the name **above every** name! (Philippians 2:9)

The Apostle Paul knew Yahshua MessiYah was **Yahweh** because he used Old Testament scriptures which spoke of **The Almighty Father** and applied those scriptures **directly** to Yahshua MessiYah.

Romans 10:13 referencing Joel 2:32
1 Corinthians 1:31 referencing Jeremiah 9:24
1 Corinthians 2:16 referencing Isaiah 40:13
1 Corinthians 10:26 referencing Psalm 24:1
2 Corinthians 10:17 referencing Jeremiah 9:24

Romans 10:13

*“For ‘WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF
THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.’”*

Paul is referencing **Joel 2:32**

*“And it will come about that whoever calls on the
name of the LORD will be delivered; for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem
there will be those who escape,
as the LORD has said, even among the survivors
whom the LORD calls.”*

Notice the LORD reference here is to **The Almighty Father Yahweh**. Paul takes the LORD reference in Joel 2:32 and applies it **directly** to **Yahshua MessiYah** in Romans 10:13.

In Romans 10:13 Paul quotes Joel 2:32, an Old Testament scripture referring to ‘**Yahweh**’, the unique Hebrew name for **The Almighty Father**, and applies it **directly** to **Yahshua MessiYah**.

1 Corinthians 1:31

*“So that, just as it is written, ‘
LET HIM WHO BOASTS, BOAST IN THE LORD.’”*

Jeremiah 9:24

“But let him who boasts boast of this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD who exercises lovingkindness, justice and righteousness on earth; for I delight in these things,” declares the LORD.”

Notice the LORD in 1 Corinthians 1:31 is a reference to **Yahshua MessiYah**, while Jeremiah is a reference to **The Almighty Father Yahweh**.

1 Corinthians 2:16

*“For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD,
THAT HE WILL INSTRUCT HIM?
But we have the mind of MessiYah.”*

Isaiah 40:13

*“Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD,
Or as His counselor has informed Him?”*

Notice, The LORD in the context of 1 Corinthians 2:16 is **Yahshua MessiYah**, while the LORD in Isaiah 40:13 is **The Almighty Father Yahweh**.

1 Corinthians 10:26

*“FOR THE EARTH IS THE LORD’S,
AND ALL IT CONTAINS.”*

Psalms 24:1

*“The earth is the LORD’S, and all it contains,
the world, and those who dwell in it.”*

Notice the LORD in the context of 1 Corinthians 10:26 is **Yahshua MessiYah**, while the LORD in Psalm 24:1 is **The Almighty Father Yahweh**.

2 Corinthians 10:17

“But HE WHO BOASTS IS TO BOAST IN THE LORD.”

Jeremiah 9:24

*“But let him who boasts boast of this,
that he understands and knows Me,
that I am the LORD who exercises lovingkindness, justice and
righteousness on earth;
for I delight in these things,’ declares the LORD.”*

Notice the LORD in the context of 2 Corinthians 10:17 is **Yahshua MessiYah**, while the LORD in Jeremiah 9:24 is **The Almighty Father Yahweh**.

There is only one King in The ‘Kingdom of God’ - The Almighty Father

The Scriptures clearly say that **The Almighty Father** is our **King**.

The Scriptures clearly say that **Yahshua MessiYah** is our **King**.

Does the ‘Kingdom of God’ have two Kings?

No, **The Almighty Father** is our only King.

The Apostle Paul gives us understanding

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 8:6, “*for us there is one God, the Father.*”

Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:6 there is “*one God and Father of all.*”

Paul, then tells us our “*one God, the Father*”, manifested Himself in flesh.

“God was manifested in the flesh”

1 Timothy 3:16

(Notice that Paul does not say, Gods ‘son’ was manifested in the flesh.)

Paul says this of **Yahshua MessiYah** in Titus 2:13

*“looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing
of our great **God** and Savior
Jesus Christ” (**Yahshua MessiYah**)*

**Zechariah's prophecy –
The King will ride into Jerusalem on a donkey**

*“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, **your King is coming to you**;
He is just and having salvation,
Lowly and **riding on a donkey**,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.*

Zechariah 9:9

**Zechariah's prophecy fulfilled -
Yahshua MessiYah enters Jerusalem
riding on a donkey.
(Matthew 21:1 – 21:11)**

*“All this was done that it might be fulfilled
which was spoken by the prophet, saying:*

*“Tell the daughter of Zion,
‘Behold, **your King is coming to you**,
Lowly, and **sitting on a donkey**,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.’*

Matthew 21:5



The Almighty Father says He will be pierced

*“And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem
the Spirit of grace and supplication;
then they will look on Me whom they pierced.”*

The Almighty Father ... Zechariah 12:10



This prophecy, regarding “***whom they pierced***” is remarkable because it is **The Almighty Father Himself** speaking.

The Almighty Father says clearly,

“they will look on Me whom they pierced”

It was **Yahshua MessiYah, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh who was pierced.**

The **invisible** Father manifested **Himself** in flesh **as our MessiYah** to **fulfill** 'the Law' on **our** behalf, and to **shed His blood for us** as **our** atoning sacrifice.

In Acts 20:28, The apostle Paul tells the church elders in Ephesus...

*"Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of **God** which **He** purchased with **His own blood**."*

Acts 20:28



The Almighty Father tells us in Isaiah 43:11 "there is no other Savior but **Me**."

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do **for us** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. **He fulfilled the demands of the Law as a perfect man of flesh**, so that **He** could be **our perfect sacrifice** and **'kinsman-redeemer'!**

On the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, paying **our** price and thereby making us **"holy, blameless"** and **"without a single fault"** in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)
This is the gospel! **This is the Good News!**

Everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured.

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
